This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:	
R 400.14205	Health of a licensee, direct care staff, administrator, other employees, those volunteers under the direction of the licensee, and members of the household.
	(4) A licensee shall provide the department with written evidence that he or she and the administrator have been tested for communicable tuberculosis and that if the disease is present, appropriate precautions shall be taken. The results of subsequent testing shall be verified every 3 years thereafter.
Tuberculin tests for Scott and Lisa Ostrander had not been completed within the past 3 years.	

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan and full approval from the State Fire Marshal, renewal of the license is recommended.
