# **III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

#### R 325.1923 Employee's health.

(2) A home shall provide initial tuberculosis screening at no cost for its employees. New employees shall be screened within 10 days of hire and before occupational exposure. The screening type and frequency of routine tuberculosis (TB) testing shall be determined by a risk assessment as described in the 2005 MMWR ?Guidelines for Preventing the Transmission of Mycobacterium tuberculosis in Health-Care Settings, 2005? (http://www.cdc.gov/mmwr/pdf/rr/rr5417.pdf), Appendices B and C, and any subsequent guidelines as published by the centers for disease control and prevention. Each home, and each location or venue of care, if a home provides care at multiple locations, shall complete a risk assessment annually. Homes that are low risk do not need to conduct annual TB testing for employees.

Review of Employee #1's file read she received a TB test on 6/29/2021 and it was read on 7/1/2021. Review of Employee #1's offer of employment letter signed by Employee #1 on 8/20/2021 read her start date was 8/30/2021. Review of new employee onboarding sign in sheet dated 8/30/2021 revealed Employee #1 attended the facility's orientation on that day and read "no TB" next to her name. Based on this information, the facility was not incompliance with this rule.

#### R 325.1932 Resident medications.

(1) Medication shall be given, taken, or applied pursuant to labeling instructions or orders by the prescribing licensed health care professional. Review of Resident A's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Potassium CL on 1/12/2022, 1/31/2022 and 2/28/2022, Magnesium Oxide on 2/2/2022, 2/25/2022, 2/28/2022, Fentanyl patch on 2/5/2022, Furosemide on 2/14/2022, 2/16/2022, 2/21/2022, Omeprazole on 1/1/2022, Escitalopram on 1/2/2022, Gabapentin on 1/2/2022, Januvia on 1/2/2022, Tamsulosin on 1/11/2022, Nystatin powder on 1/5/2022 at 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM, 1/6/2022 at 8:00 AM, 12:00 PM and 4:00 PM, and Vanicream to be administered from 10:00 PM – 6:00 AM on 1/1/2022, 1/3/2022 through 1/5/2022, 1/7/2022, 1/15/2022 through 1/29/2022 and 1/31/2022, and Vanicream to be administered from 6:00 AM – 2:00 PM on 1/31/2022.

Review of Resident B's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Basaglar kwikpen on 2/27/2022 and 2/28/2022, Biotene 5:00 PM doses on 2/3/2022 and 2/28/2022, Diltiazem on 2/3/2022, Docusate Sodium 5:00 PM dose on 2/28/2022, Donepezil on 2/28/2022, Genteal tears 2:00 PM dose on 2/25/2022, 2:00 PM and 8:00 PM doses on 2/28/2022, Hydrocodone 8:00 PM doses on 2/22/2022 and 2/28/2022, Metoprolol 5:00 PM dose on 2/28/2022, Carbidopa levodopa 6:00 AM doses on 2/21/2022, 2/23/2022, 2/28/2022, 4:00 PM doses on 2/4/2022, 2/22/2022, 2/28/2022 and 8:00 PM dose on 2/28/2022, Ventolin 8:00 AM dose on 1/6/2022, 5:00 PM doses on 1/5/2022, 2/4/2022, 2/16/2022, 2/17/2022, 2/22/2022 and 2/28/2022, Diclofenac sodium 8:00 AM doses on 1/6/2022 and 1/11/2022, 2:00 PM doses on 1/6/2022 and 1/11/2022, 8:00 PM doses on 1/5/2022 and AM dose on 1/6/2022. Resident B's blood sugar flow sheets for January 2022 and February 2022 were not always completed with the staff's initials, the resident's blood sugar results and units of insulin given.

Review of Resident C's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Potassium CL on 5:00 PM dose on 2/19/2022, Tamsulosin on 1/26/2022 and 2/19/2022, and both Vitamin D3 and Vitamin C on 2/10/2022.

Review of Resident D's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Vitamin D3 on 1/14/2022.

Review of Resident E's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Atorvastatin on 2/27/2022, Carvedilol on 2/28/2022, Clopidogrel on 2/28/2022, Dantrolene Sodium on 2/28/2022, and Hydralazine 6:00 AM dose on 2/28/2022. Resident E's diabetic monitoring flow sheet was left blank from 5:00 PM on 1/20/2022 through 1/31/2022.

Review of Resident F's MARs revealed the following medications were not marked as administered Lubricant eye drops 5:00 PM dose on 2/6/2022, Acetaminophen 8:00 AM dose on 1/28/2022, Aspirin on 1/28/2022 and 1/31/2022, and Metoprolol 8:00 PM dose on 1/31/2022.

Facility staff failed to mark any reason for the missed doses and the MARs were left blank, therefore it cannot be confirmed why the medication administrations were not completed as scheduled.

# **IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
