III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14315 Handling of resident funds and valuables.

- (9) A resident's account shall be individual to the resident. A licensee shall be prohibited from having any ownership interest in a resident's account and shall verify such in a written statement to the resident or the resident's designated representative.
 - The resident funds (petty cash) were not kept separate and individual to each resident.

R 400.14401 Environmental health.

- (2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.
 - The hot water temperature was 125.6 degrees
 Fahrenheit at the faucet. The water temperature was adjusted prior to the conclusion of the on-site inspection.

R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

- (5) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be finished so as to be easily cleanable and shall be kept clean and in good repair.
 - The ceiling tiles in two resident bedrooms were stained or missing and needed to be replaced.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/25/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable corrective action plan has been received. Renewal of the license is recommended.
