**ALLEGATION:**

**There are a lot of bugs at the facility, and it is filthy.**

**INVESTIGATION:**

On 09/20/2022, I conducted an unannounced onsite inspection at the facility. When I arrived, staff called the licensee designee, Casmir Nnaji. He denied there being a problem with bugs. He stated when he first purchased the home there was an issue with roaches. He had to have it exterminated and had to provide proof that the home was treated and free of roaches before he could get licensed. He denied having an issue with any other bugs. Mr. Nnaji also reported that the home is cleaned daily and that he is there often and even assists staff with cleaning the house.

On 09/20/2022, I interviewed Resident A and B outside separately. They both reported that Mr. Nnaji and staff cleans the house daily, but the home has ants, flies, and gnats.

On 09/20/2022, I interviewed Resident C in her bedroom. She stated staff cleans the house daily but there is an issue with ants, flies, and gnats in the home and that they even are in her room.

During my onsite inspection at the facility on 09/20/2022, I observed the facility to be clean. The floors appeared to have been swept and mopped. The living room, dining room, and kitchen were all tidy. However, several ants, gnats, and flies were observed throughout the home which I brought to staff, Regina Nnaji's, attention. Ants were crawling on the kitchen counters and were observed on the window ledge. They were also observed on the kitchen and dining area floor. Gnats were observed throughout the home but were more concentrated in the kitchen area, and flies were observed throughout the home. I also noticed that there were no screen doors and residents were leaving the main door open when they went in and out, which contributes to the problem.

<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Based on the information obtained during this investigation, the home is not being maintained adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of the residents. Several flies, gnats, and ants were observed throughout the home.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the status of the license remains unchanged.
