### ALLEGATION:

**Cold food is being served to residents.**

### INVESTIGATION:

On 12/7/22, the department received a complaint that accused the facility of serving cold food to the residents. The complaint did not provide any dates that this allegedly occurred on. Due to the anonymous nature of the complaint, I was unable to obtain any additional information.

On 12/7/22, licensing staff made a request to the facility administrator to provide food temperature logs, menus and meal census records. Review of the food temperature logs revealed that all documented temperatures were within safe ranges (hot food served at 140 degrees Fahrenheit or above and cold foods served at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below).

<b>APPLICABLE RULE</b>	
<b>R 325.1976</b>	<b>Kitchen and dietary.</b>
	<b>(6) Food and drink used in the home shall be clean and wholesome and shall be manufactured, handled, stored, prepared, transported, and served so as to be safe for human consumption.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Facility documentation reveal food temperatures were served at the recommended safe temperature level.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED</b>

#### **ADDITIONAL FINDINGS:**

#### **INVESTIGATION:**

Facility menus and meal census records were reviewed. The facility menus listed several alternative meal options available to residents, however the meal census did not indicate that any alternatives were made or served. Administrator Michael Farrell reported that the facility's chef confirmed that menu alternatives were served to residents during the timeframe reviewed, however they were not included in the meal census.

<b>APPLICABLE RULE</b>	
<b>R 325.1954</b>	<b>Meal and food records.</b>
	<b>The home shall maintain a record of the meal census, to include residents, personnel, and visitors, and a record of the kind and amount of food used for the preceding 3-month period.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	The facility's meal census did not contain an accurate account of all food prepared and served during the timeframe reviewed.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon approval of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the status of the license remain unchanged.
