## II. Purpose of Addendum

To confirm that the number of beds approved for occupancy has increased from 55 beds to 71 beds due to the completion of the facilities building project adding a 16 bed memory care (MC) unit.

## III. Methodology

- On August 21, 2021, the department received an application and appropriate supporting documentation requesting approval for a building project consisting of an addition to the back of the existing building adding a 16 bed memory care unit.
- On September 1, 2021, the department approved the facilities building project request.
- On January 25, 2023, the Health Facilities Engineering Section (HFES) notified the Bureau of Community and Health Systems that HFES done an inspection at the facility and approved the completed 16 bed MC addition.
- On February 10, 2023, I completed an inspection of the new MC addition and notified facility administration of approval for occupancy. Facility administration reported the area previously used as a memory care would be utilized as a part of the assisted living (AL).

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The number of beds for Midland Bickford Cottage was increased from 55 to 71 beds.

## V. Recommendation

I recommend the approval of a bed capacity increase for Midland Bickford Cottage from 55 to 71 beds.
