III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Physical Description of Facility

The home is located in Newaygo County, northwest of the city of White Cloud. The facility is a ranch-style home consisting of four resident bedrooms and a staff bedroom. There is a full bath for residents and a bath and a half for staff use. The facility has a living room, dining room, kitchen and a sitting area off of the kitchen. The facility does not have a basement and it is not barrier free.

B. Program Description

The licensees are experienced in working with adults with a mental illness and/or a developmental disability who present significant behavioral issues. Residents must be 18 years of age, or older and the licensee intends to work primarily with males in the facility. The licensees intend to contract with Newaygo County Community Mental Health for referrals. The licensees will work with residents to implement behavior plans, as needed, and self care plans, as developed. The licensees will work to support resident recreational activities in the facility and in the community as activities are available and as residents choose to participate.

C. Rule/Statutory Violations

R 400.14401 Environmental health.

(4) All garbage and rubbish that contains food wastes shall be kept in leak proof, nonabsorbent containers. The containers shall be kept covered with tight-fitting lids and shall be removed from the home daily and from the premises at least weekly.

- Kitchen wastebaskets need to be covered – Corrected.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 400.14402 Food service.

(3) All perishable food shall be stored at temperatures that will protect against spoilage. All potentially hazardous food shall be kept at safe temperatures. This means that all cold foods are to be kept cold, 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below, and that all hot foods are to be kept hot, 140 degrees Fahrenheit or above, except during periods that are necessary for preparation and service. Refrigerators and freezers shall be equipped with approved thermometers.

- A thermometer needs to be placed in the freezer – Corrected.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

(9) Stairway risers and treads shall be a uniform and consistent size. Stairways that form a part of a required means of egress shall change direction at landings only.

- The ground around the bottom step off of the deck at the rear of the facility needs to be leveled around step – Acceptable plan of correction submitted.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a temporary license to this AFC adult small group home (capacity 6).
