### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

**R 330.1803            Facility environment; fire safety.**

**(1) A facility that has a capacity of 4 to 6 clients shall be equipped with an interconnected multi-station smoke detection system which is powered by the household electrical service and which, when activated, initiates an alarm that is audible in all areas of the home. The smoke detection system shall be installed on all levels, including basements, common activity areas, and outside each sleeping area, but excluding crawl spaces and unfinished attics, so as to provide full coverage of the home. The system shall include a battery backup to assure that the system is operable if there is an electrical power failure and accommodate the sensory impairments of clients living in the facility, if needed. A fire safety system shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions by a licensed electrical contractor and inspected annually. A record of the inspections shall be maintained at the facility.**

At the time of inspection, the multi-station smoke detection system was not interconnected and was not audible in all areas of the home.

**R 400.14312           Resident medications.**

**(1) Prescription medication, including dietary supplements, or individual special medical procedures shall be given, taken, or applied only as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist. Prescription medication shall be kept in the original pharmacy-supplied container, which shall be labeled for the specified resident in accordance with the requirements of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being {333.1101 et seq. of the Michigan Compiled Laws, kept with the equipment to administer it in a locked cabinet or drawer, and refrigerated if required.**

At the time of inspection, I observed over-the-counter medications in Resident A's medication bin. The medications included Vitamin D3 25MCG (1000 IU); B-Complex with Folic Acid Plus Vitamin C; Vitamin C 500MG. According to the medication administration records (MARs), the medication was administered as follows:

- Vitamin D3 25MCG (1000 IU), take 1 CAP every morning at 8:00 a.m.
- B-Complex with Folic Acid Plus Vitamin C, take 1 TAB every morning at 8:00 a.m.
- Vitamin C 500MG, take 1 CAP every morning at 8:00 a.m.

According to Chinyelu Anwunah, Resident A's sister purchased the medications and the direct care staff administer the medications based on the instructions on the medication bottle.

**R 400.14312            Resident medications.**

(2) Medication shall be given, taken, or applied pursuant to label instructions.

At the time of inspection, Resident A's medications were not given, taken, or applied pursuant to label instructions.

- Levothyroxin TAB 75mcg; take 1 tablet by mouth every morning on empty stomach per label instructions. The medication administration record was not initialed 03/01/2023 – 03/17/2023. According to Chinyelu Anwunah the medication was not discontinued, no explanation provided.

- Mesalamine ER 0.375-gram CAP; take 4 capsules (=1.5GM) by mouth daily per label instructions. Per the medication administration record 1 capsule was given twice daily. According to Chinyelu Anwunah the medication was not documented correctly on the medication administration record by the direct care staff.

**R 400.14401            Environmental health.**

(2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.

At the time of inspection, the hot water temperature for resident's use did not range between 105 to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet:

- Main Bathroom (2<sup>nd</sup> level), 143.6 degrees Fahrenheit
- Bathroom (Resident bedroom 2<sup>nd</sup> level) 134.6 degrees Fahrenheit
- Main Bathroom (Main level) 129 degrees Fahrenheit

Corrected onsite; staff turned the hot water tank down.

**R 400.14401            Environmental health.**

(6) Poisons, caustics, and other dangerous materials shall be stored and safeguarded in nonresident areas and in non-food preparation storage areas.

At the time of inspection, cleaning supplies were not safeguarded and observed underneath the sink in the bathroom in the resident bedroom.

Corrected onsite; staff removed the cleaning supplies and stored in nonresident areas.

**R 400.14403            Maintenance of premises.**

(1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.

At the time of inspection:

- The kitchen cabinet door was broken and not in good repair.
- The countertop near the sink in the kitchen is buckling from water damage and not in good repair.
- The dresser drawer in the resident bedroom (main floor) was broken and dry rotted.
- The refrigerator drawers were off track and broken.

**R 400.14407            Bathrooms.**

(3) Bathrooms shall have doors. Only positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware may be used. Hooks and eyes, bolts, bars, and other similar devices shall not be used on bathroom doors.

At the time of inspection, the bathroom door was not equipped with nonlocking against egress hardware. (Located in the Resident bedroom 2<sup>nd</sup> level).

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
