III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14205

Health of a licensee, direct care staff, administrator, other employees, those volunteers under the direction of the licensee, and members of the household.

- (6) A licensee shall annually review the health status of the administrator, direct care staff, other employees, and members of the household. Verification of annual reviews shall be maintained by the home and shall be available for department review.
 - The annual health care review for Employee #1 was outdated, as it was last reviewed on May 6, 2022.

R 400.14401 Environmental health.

- (6) Poisons, caustics, and other dangerous materials shall be stored and safeguarded in nonresident areas and in non-food preparation storage areas.
 - The cleaning products stored in the kitchen were not safeguarded.

R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

- (1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.
 - There were multiple oxygen tanks stored (upright in a box), in the basement staff office. When storing multiple oxygen tanks, they must be kept in a room not utilized for any other storage or use.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable corrective action plan has been received. Renewal of the license and the special certification is recommended.
