III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:		
R 400.14312	Resident medications.	
	(1). Prescription medication, including dietary supplements, or individual special medical procedures shall be given, taken, or applied only as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist. Prescription medication shall be kept in the original pharmacy-supplied container, which shall be labeled for the specified resident in accordance with the requirements of Act No. 368 of Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being S333.1101 et seq. of the Michigan Compiled Laws, kept with the equipment to administer it in a locked cabinet or drawer, and refrigerated if required.	

Finding: Resident A's medication Baclofen tab 10 mg take 1 tab, 3x daily was not marked/signed by staff on the MAR as administered on 06/07/2023 and 06/11/2023.

Resident A's medication Atorvastatin tab 20 mg, take 1 tab, 1x daily was not marked/signed by staff on the MAR as administered on 06/12/2023.

Licensee Response: Ms. Hinton and Ms. Robinson stated staff will be reminded and retrained on the proper documentation of resident medications.

R 400.14315	Handling of resident funds and valuables.
	(3) A licensee shall have a resident's funds and valuables transaction form completed and on file for each resident. A department form shall be used unless prior authorization for a substitute form has been granted, in writing, by the department.

Finding: Resident Funds Part 1 form was not included in Resident A's resident file.

Licensee Response: Ms. Hinton and Ms. Robinson stated because the facility does not handle Resident A's funds, this document was overlooked as part of the file and will be added as soon as possible.

R 400.14318	Emergency preparedness; evacuation plan; emergency transportation.
	(5) A licensee shall practice emergency and evacuation procedures during daytime, evening, and sleeping hours at least

once per quarter. A record of the practices shall be maintained and be available for department review.

Finding: 2 Fire drills documented for the first quarter (January, February, March) and 2^{nd} quarter (April, May, June) 2023 do not have a time of the drill documented.

Licensee Response: Ms. Hinton and Ms. Robinson stated they will remind staff to document the times fire drills are conducted each time.

R 400.14407	Bathrooms.
	(3) Bathrooms shall have doors. Only positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware may be used. Hooks and eyes, bolts, bars, and other similar devices shall not be used on bathroom doors.

Finding: One of the main resident bathrooms is not equipped with non-locking against egress hardware and should open with the twist of the doorknob.

Licensee Response: Ms. Hinton and Ms. Robinson stated they will have their maintenance person change the door hardware to meet licensing rules as soon as possible.

R 400.14408	Bedrooms generally.
	(4) Interior doorways of bedrooms that are occupied by residents shall be equipped with a side-hinged, permanently mounted door that is equipped with positive-latching, nonlocking-against-egress hardware.

Finding: All resident room doors are not equipped with non-locking against egress hardware and should open with the twist of the doorknob.

Licensee Response: Ms. Hinton and Ms. Robinson stated they will have their maintenance person change the door hardware to meet licensing rules as soon as possible.

R 400.14410	Bedroom furnishings.
	(2) A resident bedroom shall be equipped with a mirror that is appropriate for grooming.

Finding: One of the resident bedrooms is not equipped with a mirror.

Licensee Response: Ms. Robinson stated a mirror will be placed in the resident room as soon as possible.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license and special certification is recommended.
