II. Purpose of Addendum

Licensee Designee, Parvinder Buttar, has made a verbal request to modify the terms of the current license to include wheelchair accessibility.

III. Methodology


An AFC licensing renewal inspection was completed at the facility on 7/5/23. During this inspection I observed that the facility has two means of egress which can accommodate residents who require the use of a wheelchair. The front exit is at ground level and walks out to a paved sidewalk, leading to the paved parking lot. The side exit off from the dining room leads out to the wooden deck, with a wheelchair ramp attached to the deck, which leads to the paved parking lot. The facility has doorways that measure at least 30 inches wide for these two exits as well as resident bedrooms and bathrooms. The facility also has a fully accessible resident bathroom with a walk-in shower that can accommodate residents who utilize wheelchairs.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

After completion of the on-site renewal inspection, it can be determined that the facility meets the requirements for wheelchair accessibility by having adequate means of egress, sufficient accommodations for personal hygiene, and doorways that are wide enough to accommodate a wheelchair.

V. Recommendation

The license shall be updated to include the provision for wheelchair accessibility.
