**ALLEGATION: Staff Taryn Miller took Resident A on an unauthorized trip resulting in an incident in which Resident A was restrained and may have resulted in a bruise on his upper right arm.**

An APS referral was received. It stated he had an unexplained bruise on his upper right arm.

On 1/30/2024, I interviewed staff Taryn Miller. She stated she didn't want to drive Resident A to his day program as requested by her supervisor. She said she made a

bad decision to then take Resident A on an unscheduled van ride unbeknownst to the other staff on duty. She said that when she stopped at Dawn Farms, a substance abuse residential treatment center in Ann Arbor, Resident A had a behavior. She said he attacked her and she needed 2 staff from the treatment center to assist her in restraining Resident A until 2 staff from Eisenhower Center arrived to assist her. She stated she felt alone, scared, and resigned afterward because she did not feel the job was a good fit for her.

On 1/30/24, I interviewed the two Eisenhower Center staff, Zaria Warren, and Traivon Perkins, who responded to staff Taryn Miller call for assistance. They both stated staff Taryn Miller left Eisenhower Center with Resident A and no one knew their whereabouts until she called for assistance. They stated when they arrived at Dawn Farms residential center, they observed Resident A being held on the floor on his back by the two unnamed staff and Eisenhower Center staff Taryn Miller sitting on his stomach trying to get Resident A to quit pulling her hair. They said they offered Resident A a snack, which he accepted, and the incident came to an end. They said they drove Resident A back to Eisenhower Center and staff Taryn Miller drove separately back to Eisenhower Center.

On 1/30/24, I interviewed Resident A's guardian. She stated she was aware of the incident and was satisfied with his placement at Eisenhower Center.

On 1/30/24, I conducted an exit conference with the licensee designee. He stated that staff Taryn Miller's employment has been terminated at Eisenhower Center.

On 2/2/24, I attempted to interview Resident A. He is non-verbal and cognitively impaired, so he could not be interviewed. There was no evidence of a bruise when I saw him.

<b>APPLICABLE RULE</b>	
<b>R 400.15305</b>	<b>Resident protection.</b>
	<b>(3) A resident shall be treated with dignity and his or her personal needs, including protection and safety, shall be attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Since staff Taryn Miller acknowledged she made the decision to take Resident A on an unscheduled trip that resulted in an incident, she did not treat Resident A with dignity and his personal needs, including protection and safety, were not attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend no changes in the status of the license.
