III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

R 400.14204 Direct care staff; qualifications and training.

(3) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be competent before performing assigned tasks, which shall include being competent in all of the following areas:

- (b) First aid.
- (c) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation

FINDINGS: Staff member C.H. did not current First Aid/CPR certification.

R 400.14205 Health of a licensee, direct care staff, administrator, other employees, those volunteers under the direction of the licensee, and members of the household.

(6) A licensee shall annually review the health status of the administrator, direct care staff, other employees, and members of the household. Verification of annual reviews shall be maintained by the home and shall be available for department review.

FINDINGS: Staff member C.H. did not have a current Annual Health Review.

R 400.14312 Resident medications.

(7) Prescription medication that is no longer required by a resident shall be properly disposed of after consultation with a physician or a pharmacist.

FINDINGS: Resident B and Resident C had medications on hand that needed to be destroyed.

R 400.14318 Emergency preparedness; evacuation plan; emergency transportation.

(5) A licensee shall practice emergency and evacuation procedures during daytime, evening, and sleeping hours at least once per quarter. A record of the practices shall be maintained and be available for department review.

FINDINGS: No fire drills were conducted in March 2024.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, the license will be renewed.
