III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:		
R 400.14203	Licensee and administrator training requirements.	
(1) A licensee and an administrator shall complete the following educational requirements specified in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subrule, or a combination thereof, on an annual basis: (a) Participate in, and successfully complete, 16 hours of training designated or approved by the department that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement. (b) Have completed 6 credit hours at an accredited college or university in an area that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement as		
Upon inspection there were no training hours for the Licensee Designee or the home manager.		
R 400.14403	Maintenance of premises	
	(13) A yard area shall be kept reasonably free from all hazards, nuisances, refuse, and litter.	
Upon inspection it was noticed that there was a pile of wooden boards in front lawn of the home. The wooden boards had nails and screws exposed in the discarded boards.		
R 400.14505	Smoke detection equipment; location; battery replacement; testing, examination, and maintenance; spacing of detectors mounted on ceilings and walls; installation requirements for new construction, conversions, and changes of category.	
	 (1) At least 1 single-station, battery-operated smoke detector shall beinstalled at the following locations: (a) Between the sleeping areas and the rest of the home. In homes that have more than 1 sleeping area, a smoke detector shall be installed to protect each separate sleeping area. 	

	(b) On each occupied floor, in the basement, and in areas of the home that contain flame- or heat-producing equipment.
Upon inspection it was noticed that there was no smoke detector in the laundry	
room.	

R 400.1403	Maintenance of premises
	(8) Stairways shall have sturdy and securely fastened handrails. The handrails shall be not less than 30, nor more than 34, inches above the upper surface of the tread. All exterior and interior stairways and ramps shall have handrails on the open sides. All porches and decks that are inches or more above grade shall also have handrails on the open sides.
Upon inspection it was determined that the handrail leading into the front entrance of	

the facility was broken and hanging off the rail.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
