ALLEGATION:

The home did not provide for Resident A's safety and protection.

INVESTIGATION:

I received this complaint as an Adult Protective Services screen-out.

On 8/13/24, I interviewed Pathlight Division Manager Bobbi Ankney in the facility. Ms. Ankney reported that Resident A stayed with a former resident and his family over the weekend. Resident A had asked to return early but changed her mind. Upon Resident A's return on Sunday, she advised the staff that she had been inappropriately grabbed. Ms. Ankney stated that when she met Resident A on Monday, Resident A stated that she was sore and reported that she had been groped really hard over her clothing. Resident A denied wanting to make a police report or going to the hospital. Ms. Ankney advised that an incident report had been written.

Resident A stated that she knew why I was there. She stated quite loudly that CMH lied. She was visibly upset, and Ms. Ankney suggested that she use a coping skill like listening to music. Resident A accepted the advice and walked off to a shaded spot in the yard to lay down.

On 8/15/24, I received an incident report from the facility. The document reflects refusal on Resident A's part to seek treatment or make a police report. Resident A's Community Mental Health case manager was notified.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14305	Resident protection.
	(3) A resident shall be treated with dignity and his or her personal needs, including protection and safety, shall be attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.
ANALYSIS:	Based on interviews with staff and Resident A, as well as documentation provided that the issue was addressed, there is insufficient evidence to establish a violation.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

On 8/29/24, I conducted an exit conference with licensee designee Scott Brown. I shared my findings and Mr. Brown agreed with the conclusions reached.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change to the status of this license.


