III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.15401 Environmental health.

(2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.

- The hot water temperature in resident rooms 100-112 had readings between 129 degrees Fahrenheit and 131 degrees Fahrenheit.
- The hot water temperature in resident rooms 113-118 had reading between 91 degrees Fahrenheit and 101 degrees Fahrenheit.

R 400.15403 Maintenance of premises.

(1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.

- There were broken tiles in the shower as well as a small hole in the bathroom wall in room #100.
- There were broken tiles in the shower in room #102 and the toilet paper holder was missing.
- The baseboard behind the bed in room #106 was loose.
- The baseboard in the bathroom near the shower in room #116 was loose.

R 400.15403 Maintenance of premises.

(2) Home furnishings and housekeeping standards shall present a comfortable, clean, and orderly appearance.

- There was what appeared to be mold/mildew in the shower in room #102.
- The visitor seating (couch) in the hallway was old and worn.
- There was what appeared to be mold/mildew on the caulking in the main shower room.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
