ALLEGATION: Direct care staff, Jasmine Foster referred to Resident A as a whore.

INVESTIGATION: On 5/7/25, I initiated the complaint with a phone call to Recipient Rights Investigator, Domonique Moore. Later that day, I conducted an unannounced onsite inspection at the facility. I interviewed Resident A. Resident A confirmed direct care staff, Jasmine Foster referred to her in a derogatory manner on Easter Sunday. According to Resident A, Jasmine observed her outside engaging in a sexual act with a male visitor. The visitor is Resident B's son whom she was familiar with. Resident A

explained when she went back inside the facility, Jasmine shamed her by calling her a “hoe, not whore!” Resident A also said Jasmine threatened to report her to the licensee in an attempt to have her removed from the facility for engaging in behavior that Jasmine deemed unacceptable. Resident A reasoned the sexual act was consensual, so Jasmine had no right to make her feel bad. Resident A believes Jasmine told the other residents and staff because when she came indoors, “everybody was laughing.” Resident A reported that since the incident happened, she’s isolated herself to her room to avoid the embarrassment. Resident A indicated the incident had such a negative effect on her mental state that she needed to discuss it with a psychiatrist. While at the facility, I also interviewed direct care staff, Joyce Lo. Joyce said she was at the facility on the day of the incident. Joyce verified Jasmine came into the office screaming, “You nasty ... You a nasty hoe!” referring to Resident A. Joyce explained Jasmine was so loud that “everybody heard her”, including the other residents in the home. Joyce reported Taleia Mitchell was also on duty and heard what Jasmine said.

On 5/29/25, I attempted to call Taleia 3 times, but the calls wouldn’t go through. I attempted to call Jasmine the same day, but I received an outgoing message that her phone couldn’t accept calls at this time. I contacted direct care staff, Latecia Reed on 5/29/25 as well. Latecia no longer works at the facility as of 5/4/25, but she did say prior to leaving she observed Resident A with a sad affect on the day after Easter. According to Latecia, Resident A informed her that Jasmine observed her having sex through a window. Latecia said Resident A was upset that Jasmine yelled obscenities at her for everyone to hear. Per Latecia, Resident A felt disrespected by Jasmine when Jasmine told her, “You a hoe! ... You a hoe because you’re out in the alley!” Latecia confirmed Jasmine threatened to have Resident A thrown out the group home for her misdeeds.

On 5/29/25, I completed an exit conference with licensee designee, Davina Draughn. Ms. Draughn reported Taleia was “let go” during her 90-day probationary period for issues unrelated to this investigation. However, Ms. Draughn said Jasmine is still employed there. Ms. Draughn indicated that Jasmine’s phone service has been interrupted in the past, so that’s probably why my calls didn’t go through. Although Ms. Draughn was aware that Jasmine was being investigated for calling Resident A names, she stated that she wasn’t aware of the details surrounding the name calling. Therefore, Jasmine was never disciplined or reprimanded. Ms. Draughn described Jasmine as good employee. Per Ms. Draughn, “The residents love her” and “She come in and do a real good job.” I informed Ms. Draughn that my investigative findings demonstrate Jasmine used derogatory language with Resident A causing the resident to feel ashamed and embarrassed. As a result, the allegation is substantiated.

ANALYSIS:	Based on witness statements from Resident A, and DCS Joyce Lo and Latecia Reed it is confirmed DCS Jasmine Foster did subject Resident A to mental and emotional cruelty, verbal abuse, derogatory remarks about the resident, and threats on Easter Sunday, April 20, 2025.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the status of this license remain unchanged.
