This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

Medication label and medication log should be updated if administration times have changed.

The home did not complete a day or sleep time drill for the 1st quarter of 2025. The home did not complete a sleep time drill for the 2nd quarter of 2025.

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
