- The signature of the licensee or licensee designee and a date.

A six-month provisional license is recommended. If you do not contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must indicate so in writing; this may be included in your corrective action plan or in a separate document. If you contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must notify this office in writing and an administrative hearing will be scheduled. Even if you contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must still submit an acceptable corrective action plan within 15 days.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

<b>MCL 400.713</b>	<b>License required; application; forms; investigation; on-site evaluation; issuance or renewal of license; disclosures; maximum number of persons; stating type of specialized program; issuance of license to specific person at specific location; transferability of license; sale of facility; notice; items of noncompliance; refusal by department to issue or renew license; conditions; unlicensed facility; violation as misdemeanor; penalty; receipt of completed application; issuance of license within certain time period; inspections; report; criminal history and records check; storage of fingerprints in automated fingerprint identification system database; convictions; "completed application" defined.</b>
	<b>(3) Before issuing or renewing a license, the department shall investigate the activities and standards of care of the applicant and shall make an on-site evaluation of the facility. On-site inspections conducted in response to the application may be conducted without prior notice to the applicant. On-site inspections conducted for renewing a license may be conducted within 12 months before the expiration date of the current license without impact on the license renewal date or the license fee. Subject to subsections (9), (10), and (11), the department shall issue or renew a license if satisfied as to all of the following: (b) The applicant's compliance with this act and rules promulgated under this act.</b>

On 07/24/2025, I completed an onsite renewal inspection. There were no residents in care at the time the renewal inspection was conducted. The licensee has not admitted any residents into the home since the issuance of the temporary license. Therefore, compliance regarding quality of care cannot be determined at this time.

<b>R 400.14401</b>	<b>Environmental health.</b>
	<b>(2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.</b>

During the onsite inspection, I measured the water temperature with a digital thermometer. The water temperature was found to be as high as 157.6 degrees Fahrenheit.

<b>R 400.14407</b>	<b>Bathrooms.</b>
	(3) Bathrooms shall have doors. Only positive-latching, non-locking against-egress hardware may be used. Hooks and eyes, bolts, bars, and other similar devices shall not be used on bathroom doors.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that Bathroom #1 did not have non-locking against egress hardware on door.

<b>R 400.14408</b>	<b>Bedrooms generally.</b>
	(4) Interior doorways of bedrooms that are occupied by residents shall be equipped with a side-hinged, permanently mounted door that is equipped with positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that Bedroom #1, Bedroom #2 and Bedroom #3 did not have non-locking egress hardware on doors.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, issuance of a provisional license is recommended.


