ALLEGATION:

Resident A has bed bug bites.

INVESTIGATION:

On 07/18/2025, I completed an unannounced on-site inspection and interviewed Staff- Philip Mmuo and Residents B- F regarding the above allegations. It should be

noted Resident A was attending the adult day program at the time of inspection. Philip denies the home has bed bugs.

Residents B- F deny the home has bed bugs.

Resident F stated a few years ago the home had bed bugs. Resident F stated it was bad back then but now after the home was exterminated, he has not seen a bed bug.

On 07/18/2025, I telephoned and interviewed Program Manager- Chinyelu Anwunah regarding the above allegations. Chinyelu denies the home has bed bugs. Chinyelu stated Resident A refused to go to urgent care after the home was notified of the bumps on her arm. Chinyelu stated Resident A does not have a guardian.

On 08/11/2025, I telephoned and interviewed Meaghan Karafa, Quality Control Manager with America's Community Council. Meaghan stated she previously worked with Resident A as a supervisor of her case manager but she now has a different position within the agency. Meaghan stated she was examined by their nurse and doctor to confirm it was bed bugs. Meaghan stated she has had issues with the facility in the past but is unclear about these allegations.

On 08/15/2025, I completed an exit conference and spoke with Licensee Designee- Vincent Anwunah regarding the above allegations. Vincent did not have anything additional to add to these allegations.

On 08/28/2025, I completed a facetime interview via the state issued smartphone with Resident A while at ACCESS day program. Resident A was accompanied during the interview by Toma Albadery, a Staff at ACCESS day program who acted as Resident A's language interpreter. Resident A denied that she had bed bugs bits. Resident A denies there are bed bugs in the facility. Resident A stated this was a big mistake.

ANALYSIS:	<p>Program Manager- Chinyelu Anwunah Staff- Philip Mmuo and Residents A- F deny the home has bed bugs. Resident A stated this was a big mistake.</p> <p>Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support the facility has bed bugs problem. An insect, rodent, or pest control program is maintained as necessary and carried out in a manner that continually protects the health of residents</p>
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

ALLEGATIONS:

Resident A was hit on the thigh by Resident B.

INVESTIGATION:

On 07/18/2025, I completed an unannounced on-site inspection and interviewed Staff- Philip Mmuo and Residents B- F regarding the above allegations. It should be noted Resident A was attending the adult day program at the time of inspection. He stated he has no knowledge of Resident A being hit by Resident B.

Residents B- F deny that Resident B hit Resident A on the thigh. Residents B- F stated they have no knowledge of this incident taking place in the home.

On 07/18/2025, I telephoned and interviewed Program Manager- Chinyelu Anwunah regarding the above allegations. Chinyelu denies this allegation. She stated Resident A is usually at adult day program and has limited interaction with Resident B. Chinyelu stated Resident A does not have a guardian.

On 08/11/2025, I telephoned and interviewed Meaghan Karafa, Quality Control Manager with America’s Community Council. Meaghan stated she previously worked with Resident A as a supervisor of her case manager but she now has a different position within the agency. Meaghan stated she has had issues with the facility in the past but is unclear about these allegations.

On 08/15/2025, I completed an exit conference and spoke with Licensee Designee- Vincent Anwunah regarding the above allegations. Vincent did not have anything additional to add to these allegations.

On 08/28/2025, I completed a facetime interview via a smartphone with Resident A. Resident A was accompanied during the interviewed by Toma Albadery, a Staff at ACCESS day program who acted as Resident’s A language interpreter. Resident A

denies the allegations. Resident A accidentally bumped into the door with her body leaving the facility and she thought Resident B touched her on the thigh.

ANALYSIS:	<p>Program Manager- Chinyelu Anwunah Staff- Philip Mmuo and Residents A- F deny Resident A was hit by Resident B.</p> <p>Resident A stated she accidentally bumped into the door with her body leaving the facility and she thought Resident B touched her on the thigh.</p> <p>Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support Resident A was hit by Resident B. Resident A was treated with dignity and his or her personal needs, including protection and safety, was attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.</p>
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

I recommend that the status of the license remains the same.
