IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 10/17/2025, Administrator Marcus Garvin submitted documentation to change staff to resident supervision from 1:4 to 1:5. Bethesda Lutheran has currently has 8 residents in the home, but the home is licensed for 10. Bethesda Lutheran is confident in their ability to maintain consistent standards of care with additional residents without needing to add additional care. Bethesda Lutheran further understands staffing requirements may need to be increased, based on the current needs of the residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the staffing model be approved and changed from 1:4 to 1:5 staff to resident supervision. Bethesda Lutheran further understands staffing requirements may need to be increased, based on the current needs of the residents.
