Attached is the Special Investigation Report for the above referenced facility. Due to the violations identified in the report, a written corrective action plan is required. The corrective action plan is due 15 days from the date of this letter and must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

A six-month provisional license is recommended. If you do not contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must indicate so in writing; this may be included in your corrective action plan or in a separate document. If you contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must notify this office in writing and an administrative hearing will be scheduled. Even if you contest the issuance of a provisional license, you must still submit an acceptable corrective action plan.

ALLEGATION:

On 1/4/2026 Resident A eloped from the facility unsupervised.

INVESTIGATION:

On 1/12/2026 I made an APS referral.

On 1/13/2026, Resident A was not interviewed because she is non-verbal.

On 1/13/2026, I interviewed Daniel Bogosian. He stated that direct care staff, Charles Sanders, submitted the incident report describing that on 1/4/2026 Resident A eloped from the facility and was returned by a stranger. He stated that Enock Metto was the direct care staff assigned to Resident A on 1/4/2026. We reviewed Resident A's IPOS dated 2/13/2025 and her behavior treatment plan dated 1/6/2026.

Neither document required Resident A to have a 1:1 staff. However, Resident A is to be supervised every 5 minutes by an assigned staff.

On 1/13/2026, I interviewed direct care staff, Charles Sanders. He stated that on 1/4/2026 a stranger returned Resident A to the facility about 6:20 p.m. and he did not know what time she eloped from the facility as he was at the other end of the facility dealing with another resident's behavioral episode. He stated that he did not get the person's name.

On 1/13/2026, I interviewed Enock Metto. She stated that on 1/4/2026 she worked from 8:00 a.m. until noon and then went home sick.

On 1/13/2026, Daniel Bogosian stated that since Enock Metto went home sick on 1/4/2026, then Charles Sanders was the staff assigned to supervise Resident A.

On 1/13/2026, I conducted an exit conference with Daniel Bogosian. I stated that this is a repeat violation, previously investigated as 2025A0575040, sent on 8/28/2025. I stated that the CAP he submitted on 9/11/2025 stated that an assessment would be completed in 30 days requesting 1:1 staffing for Resident A. He stated that the 1:1 staffing request was denied by the Northpointe CMH. He stated that Resident A is still to be supervised on 5-minute checks.

On 1/13/2026 and 1/14/2026 I telephoned Guardian A1. My repeat telephone calls were not returned.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.671	Resident care.
	(4) A licensee shall provide supervision, protection, and personal care as specified in a resident's assessment plan.
ANALYSIS:	This is a repeat violation for the licensee not providing supervision per Resident A's assessment plan and IPOS, which has resulted in Resident A eloping from the facility and has jeopardized her health and safety and the continual responsibility of the licensee to take reasonable action to insure the well-being of a resident.
CONCLUSION:	REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED SIR 2025A0575040, report sent on 8/28/2025 and the CAP submitted on 9/11/2025. Rule R400.671(4) is the new administrative rule replacing R400.303(2) which was cited in SIR 2025A0575040.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend modification of the current status of the license to provisional.
