ALLEGATION: The licensee, Arteria Young, routinely and publicly speaks aggressively and disrespectfully to the residents, creating an ongoing hostile environment despite repeated complaints and no corrective action.

INVESTIGATION: On 12/19/25, I completed an unannounced onsite inspection at the facility. I interviewed Resident A – C. Resident D and E were not available for interview. However, Resident A – C confirmed that Ms. Young does subject residents to mental and emotional cruelty by yelling and talking to them in an aggressive tone. Specifically, Resident A reported Ms. Young, “she be yelling and get in our faces ... yelling talking about we can’t go nowhere.” Resident A also stated that Ms. Young curses at them, making statements like, “This y’all motherfucking house!” Resident A concluded, “This company do us so wrong.” Resident B corroborated Resident A’s statements reporting that Ms. Young yells at residents over the phone, as well as in-person when she comes onsite to the facility. Resident B stated Ms. Young has yelled at residents on multiple occasions. Resident C expressed a fondness for Ms. Young; however, Resident C stated Ms. Young does yell at residents, sometimes using curse words. Resident C also reported being “afraid” of Ms. Young. Resident A – C’s statements are consistent. Resident A – C denied Ms. Youngs gets physical with residents. Staff 1 and Staff 2 both denied having ever witnessed Ms. Young yell at the residents or talk to them in a disrespectful manner. However, Staff 1 and Staff 2 indicated Ms. Young does place the residents on “restriction” for exhibiting unacceptable behavior, meaning they are not permitted to go anywhere. Staff 3 described Ms. Young as “very firm” and that she talks to the residents in a “Mama voice, like she’s talking to a kid.” Staff 3 reported residents have complained to her about the way Ms. Youngs speaks to them. Staff 3 confirmed Ms. Young does revoke resident privileges if they fail to do their tasks at home like, cleanup room, laundry, or perform hygiene. Staff 4 reported that Ms. Young “she tends to speak to them in a belittling manner,” referring to the residents. Staff 4 also reported Ms. Young does raise her voice with residents.

On 1/6/25, I received a direct call from Ms. Young following the onsite inspection. Ms. Young denied yelling at or cursing at residents, but she quickly admitted that she does tell the residents, “Y’all are grown ass women.” Ms. Young indicated that she talks firmly to residents, not abusive.

On 1/9/26, I interviewed Clinical Psychologist, Cheryl Scott with Wayne Center. Ms. Scott stated she has never met Ms. Young in person, so she hasn’t witnessed her interact with residents. Therefore, Ms. Scott was not able to contribute any relevant information to the investigation.

On 1/21/26, I completed an exit conference with Ms. Young. Ms. Young indicated that she understands the outcome of the investigation, but she maintains that she did not verbally or mentally abuse the residents in her care.

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the status of this license remain unchanged.
