III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.631 Health screenings.

(4) A licensee shall annually review and maintain in the facility the health status of the staff and members of the household. Verification of annual reviews must be maintained for 2 years.

At the time of inspection, direct care staff, Diann Lemuel employee file did not contain a 2024 annual health review.

R 400.637 Handling of resident funds and valuables.

(4) A licensee shall record in the resident record a resident funds and itemized transactions including payment for services provided for each resident.

At the time of inspection, Resident B's resident funds part II was not available for department review.

R 400.675 Resident medications.

(4) A licensee, administrator, or direct care staff shall comply with the following when supervising the taking of medication by a resident:

(b) Complete an individual medication log that contains all of the following:

(i) Medication name.

(ii) Dosage.

(iii) Label instructions for use.

(iv) Time to be administered.

(v) Initials of the individual who administered the medication at the time given.

(vi) Resident's refusal to accept prescribed medication or procedures at time of refusal.

At the time of inspection, Residents A and B's medication administration records were not available for department review.

R 400.691 Resident records.

(1) A licensee shall complete and maintain a separate record for each resident that includes all of the following:

(g) Admission and monthly weight record.

At the time of inspection, Resident B's weight records were not available for department review.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
