## II. Purpose of Addendum

The facility is currently licensed to provide 24-hour supervision, protection, and personal care to the developmentally disabled, aged, traumatically brain injured and Alzheimer's populations. Licensee designee and administrator Georgina Adatsi has requested the facility also provide adult foster care services to the physically handicapped populations.

Georgina Adatsi submitted an updated Program Statement and Admission Policy that includes the program goals and services to be provided to the developmentally disabled, aged, traumatically brain injured, physically handicapped and Alzheimer's populations.

Rivers Residence is an Adult Foster Care home licensed for up to 6 male and/or female residents, who may belong to the following populations: aged, physically handicapped, traumatic brain injury, developmentally disabled, and Alzheimer's populations. Program elements will be provided by the managerial and direct care staff, volunteers and residents' families and friends.

While providing direct physical care, Rivers Residence will fulfill resident social, emotional, and spiritual needs. Organized and impromptu social gatherings centering around daily meals, games, arts and crafts, exercise, birthday parties, holidays, and other group activities are a daily part of the choices our residents have in how they spend their time. Whenever possible, personal interests are coordinated into group and individual activities, such as gardening or enjoying the company of a therapy animal. Through local churches, Rivers Residence provide opportunities for group nondenominational spiritual studies. Residents' families and friends are always welcome to participate in and enjoy these activities.

Each resident is a valued member of the community at Rivers Residence. Families will be kept well informed of any physical or mental changes that may occur in their loved one. Providing a safe, clean and comfortable home for residents is Rivers Residence top priority, and regular communication between residents, families and staff will help ensure that all residents' needs are being met to the best of Rivers Residence ability.

Georgina Adatsi meets the qualifications and training requirements identified in the group home administrative rules and has over two years of experience working with developmentally disabled, aged, traumatically brain injured, physically handicapped and Alzheimer's populations. Direct care staff are currently trained to provide services to the identified populations. Training verification is maintained in the employees' records.

Georgina Adatsi acknowledged this facility is not currently wheelchair accessible, and any resident admitted to this facility with mobility impairments will not require the use of expanded doorways or means of egress equipped with ramps.

**III. Methodology**

On 03/02/2026 Georgina Adatsi requested the facility provide 24-hour supervision, protection, and personal care to residents who are developmentally disabled, aged, traumatically brain injured and Alzheimer’s populations. Along with this request, Georgina Adatsi submitted a revised Program Statement and Admission Policy as well as verification she meets the qualifications and training requirements identified in the group home administrative rules.

**IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

Compliance with the licensing act and administrative rules related to Program Type have been determined.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend the physically handicapped population be added to the facility’s program type.
