**ALLEGATION:**

**An aggressive dog has bitten residents in the facility.**

**INVESTIGATION:**

On 3/3/26, I received an email from Adult Protective Services Specialist Betsy Clark. Ms. Clark advised that she had been to the facility and none of the residents reported ever being bitten by a dog.

On 3/13/26, I interviewed licensee Jessica Taylor in the facility. Ms. Taylor denied that her dog has ever bitten any of the residents. Ms. Taylor advised that one morning, an employee showed up earlier than expected and may have stepped on the dog accidentally, resulting in the dog nipping at her heel. Ms. Taylor stated that the employee's skin was not punctured. Ms. Taylor stated that APS had been to the home and questioned several residents, all of whom denied that they were bitten by the dog.

I interviewed Resident A in the facility. Resident A denied being bitten by the dog.

I interviewed Resident Bin the facility. Resident B denied being bitten by the dog.

Licensee Jason Taylor provided a copy of the dog license.

On 4/2/26, I interviewed the source by telephone. The source was unsure if residents had actually been bitten but was concerned that it could happen in light of the employee's circumstances.

<b>APPLICABLE RULE</b>	
<b>R 400.641</b>	<b>Resident behavior interventions.</b>
	<b>(5) Staff, volunteers, visitors, or other occupants of the facility shall not mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission that exposes a resident to a serious risk, physical or emotional harm, or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Based on interviews with Residents, as well as Adult Protective Services, there is insufficient evidence to establish a violation. The source was also unsure whether any residents were ever bitten by the dog.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED</b>

On 4/3/26 I conducted an exit conference with licensee Jason Taylor. I shared my findings and Mr. Taylor agreed with the conclusions reached.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change to the status of this license.




