ALLEGATION:

Staff hit and shouted at a resident.

INVESTIGATION:

On 3/12/26, I interviewed employee Bobbie Cilley in the home. Ms. Cilley stated that she had not heard of any altercation between Resident A and Ms. Montecinos. She stated that the only incident she recalled involved Resident A hitting another resident around Valentine's Day, over a dispute about a rather trivial matter concerning a date.

I interviewed Resident A in the facility along with Adult Protective Services Specialist Jason Harris. Resident A stated that she hit Ms. Montecinos in the arm and then Ms. Montecinos retaliated by hitting her on the arm as well. During the interview Resident A seemed confused about dates and time.

I interviewed employee Erica Montecinos in the facility. Ms. Montecinos was initially unaware of any reference to striking Resident A, denying having done so. She advised that of late, Resident A has been exhibiting more aggressive behaviors. She was able to recall an event a few weeks prior, when Resident A was screaming at night, she went in Resident A's room to investigate, and ended up being hit. She

stated that she put some distance between herself and Resident A, and acknowledged that she spoke firmly to Resident A about the physical violence.

I interviewed Resident B in the facility. Resident B was asked if she had any negative interactions with other residents. She recalled being struck by Resident A a few weeks ago.

On 4/17/26, I conferred with APS Specialist Jason Harris, by telephone. Mr. Harris reported that there did not seem to be enough evidence to establish a violation.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(5) Staff, volunteers, visitors, or other occupants of the facility shall not mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission that exposes a resident to a serious risk, physical or emotional harm, or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.
ANALYSIS:	Both Ms. Montecinos and Resident A reported that Resident A struck Ms. Montecinos. There were no witnesses to Ms. Montecinos retaliating. There is insufficient evidence to establish a violation.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

On 4/13/26, I conducted an exit conference with licensee Vicky Cates, where I shared my findings.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change to the status of this license.


