III. METHODOLOGY

ALLEGATION:

Resident A was pushed by employee Mya Thompson.

INVESTIGATION:

On 3/4/26, I interviewed Resident A in the facility. Resident A stated that soon after another resident moved out, employee Mya Thompson adopted a rude attitude toward her. She stated that Home Manager Adriana Garcia stopped talking to her. She stated that Ms. Garcia was not truthful with her about getting funds to do shopping for her. She denied that there were any witnesses to Ms. Thompson mistreating her by pushing her out of the way. She denied sustaining any injuries.

I interviewed employee Bailey Garcia in the facility. Ms. Garcia stated that she has never witnessed anyone push Resident A, nor has she seen her fellow employees similarly mistreat other residents.

I interviewed Resident B in the facility. Resident B reported that she likes the home atmosphere and denied any reports of staff shoving residents.

On 3/38/26, I interviewed Home Manager Adriana Garcia in the facility. Ms. Garcia was scheduling Resident A to attend a shopping trip. Ms. Garcia denied witnessing staff or Mya Thompson specifically, pushing Resident A.

I interviewed employee Mya Thompson in the facility. Ms. Thompson denied shoving Resident A or being physical with any other residents. Ms. Thompson stated that Resident A has a pattern of making false claims against caregivers, when she is upset about not getting her way.

I interviewed Resident A in the facility. Resident A retracted her claim that she was being mistreated.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(5) Staff, volunteers, visitors, or other occupants of the facility shall not mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission that exposes a resident to a serious risk, physical or emotional harm, or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.
ANALYSIS:	Interviews revealed that there were no witnesses to Mya Thompson mistreating Resident A by pushing her. Resident A subsequently retracted her allegation.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

On 3/31/26, I conducted an exit conference with licensee designee Bishop Ira Combs. I shared my findings and Bishop Combs agreed with the conclusions reached.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change to the status of this license.


