ALLEGATION:

- **On 03/10/2026, Resident A was helping another resident in the living room. Unprovoked, Staff Alonzo Simmons stated to Resident A, "You're a spoiled little bitch".**
- **On 03/10/2026, Staff Alonzo Simmons refused to give Resident A a banana and insisted she have an apple or orange.**

INVESTIGATION:

On 03/20/2026, the local licensing office received a complaint for investigation. Adult Protective Services (APS) dismissed the complaint and referred it to licensing.

On 04/01/2026, I made an unannounced onsite at Krasinski AFC Home, located in Saginaw County Michigan. Interviewed was Home Manager, Tammy Haley. Resident A was at program during my onsite.

On 04/01/2026, I interviewed Home Manager (HM), Tammy Haley regarding the allegations. Tammy Haley informed that she was working down the street at the other home when she texted Staff, ShunRhoneka Tyler to pack up some clothes for another resident because that resident was going to a nursing home for a few days for recovery. Staff Alonzo Simmons then called her and asked if Resident A is supposed to be in another resident's bedroom and she told him, "No." Resident A went in the room although she has a history of taking things. Tammy Haley could hear Resident A yelling while on the phone with Staff Alonzo Simmons saying, "You aren't the boss of me! You can't tell me what to do! Fuck you!" Alonzo Simmons responded. "Well, Fuck you too!" Tammy Haley told Alonzo Simmons to stop and she's on her way back to the home. When Tammy Haley arrived, everything was quiet and Resident A was in a meeting with her case manager. In regard to the fruit, she is unsure if the fruit was denied as there is plenty of fruit there and residents are welcome to fruit or whenever they want. The fruit is accessible and they really don't have to ask. Tammy Haley informed that she did counsel Staff Alonzo Simmons on proper communication with residents.

On 05/14/2026, I made another onsite to Krasinski AFC Home and spoke with Resident A regarding the allegations. Resident A informed that all she did was go with Staff ShunRhoneka Tyler to help with getting another resident's clothes together because she was going away. Staff Alonzo Simmons came into the bedroom and yelled, "What are you doing in here? You steal too much!" Resident A informed that she was in the room with staff, but Alonzo Simmons kept yelling at her. Resident A told Staff Simmons that he was not her daddy, and he said, "I don't want to be your fucking daddy!" Resident A then closed the door in Staff Simmons's face. Alonzo Simmons then opened the door and called her a "spoiled little Bitch." Regarding the incident with fruit, Staff Alonzo Simmons denied Resident A from having a banana, but all the other residents were able to eat bananas. Resident A informed that bananas were on the menu for the day, so she should have been able to have a banana, especially since there were plenty of bananas left.

On 05/14/2026, I spoke with Staff ShunRhoneka Tyler regarding the allegations. ShunRhoneka Tyler informed that she was there sitting at the table with Resident A and two other residents and they were just coloring. The Home Manager, Tammy Haley called her and asked her to pick out 4 outfits for another resident because that resident was going away for a few days. ShunRhoneka Tyler got up and asked Resident A if she wanted to help and she said, "Okay." There are two beds in the room and Resident A did not go near the other bed. Resident A just mostly stood there while she was gathering the other resident's clothing. Staff Tyler just had Resident A double check if she had 4 tops, 4 bottoms, 4 underwear, etc., just so she had something to do because they were doing an activity. Staff Tyler could see that Staff Alonzo Simmons was on the phone, but at this time she was not aware of who he was on the phone with. When Alonzo Simmons looked up and observed that Resident A was in the bedroom, he came into the room and told Resident A, "Get out of here! You know you're not supposed to be in here." Resident A responded, "I'm in here with staff." The Alonzo Simmons said, "I don't care, get out of there." Resident A told Alonzo Simmons that he wasn't her daddy, and he said he don't want to be her "fucking daddy." That's when Resident A slammed the door closed. Alonzo Simmons opened the door, and they continued to go back and forth with one another. ShunRhoneka Tyler said that it was clear that Resident A was in the room with her and wasn't doing anything wrong. If Staff Simmons wanted Resident A to leave, he could have asked her in a better way or could have told her, "Hey, you know (Resident A) can't be in here", then she would have said, "Okay", and would have told Resident A that she had to step out of the room. While the two of them were continuing to go back and forth, she could hear the Home Manager, Tammy Haley on the phone saying, "Tell (Resident A) I'm on my way." That's when Staff Tyler realized that Staff Alonzo Simmons was already on the phone with the home manager the entire time, even before the incident began. In regard to the issue with the fruit, Staff Tyler heard about it, but it either happened another day or after she left for the day. Staff Tyler heard that Alonzo Simmons denied Resident A access to the bananas, but she doesn't know if that occurred. Residents are supposed to be able to get fruit whenever they want it.

On 05/14/2026, I interviewed former staff, Alonzo Simmons regarding the allegations. Alonzo Simmons informed that he observed Resident A in another resident's room which she is not supposed to be in another resident's room, but the staff brought Resident A in there anyways. The staff was supposed to be gathering some clothes for another resident. Staff Simmons was not sure why Staff Tyler had Resident A was in there with Staff Tyler as that's not allowed per their manager. Alonzo Simmons told Resident A that she could not be in there, and Resident A responded by giving him the middle finger. Alonzo Simmons said that he was calm throughout the interaction. Resident A proceeded to tell Staff Simmons that she was not coming out of the room because she was with staff. At some point, Resident A said, "Fuck you!" Staff Simmons admitted to saying it back to her, but that was the only derogatory thing that was said to Resident A. Prior to this, Staff Simmons and Resident A never had any issues. Regarding the issue with the fruit, there were never any issues regarding fruit. Residents are able to have fruit when they want it.

Staff Simmons believes that staff and Resident A have conspired against him to get him terminated, which did occur.

On 05/14/2026, I spoke with Home Manager, Kaila Klepsch regarding the allegations. Kaila Klepsch informed that Resident A and Staff, Alonzo Simmons were not getting along and there were other incidents which led her to terminate Alonzo Simmons employment. In another incident, Resident A and Alonzo Simmons got into another verbal confrontation in the kitchen. When Alonzo Simmons was questioned, he denied everything. They typically don't want residents in other residents' rooms, but they would just simply ask them to come out, but there's no rules against it. In this situation, Resident A was given permission to be there. Kaila Klepsch is not aware of any issues regarding fruit, but they should be able to have the fruit of their choice if it's there.

On 05/14/2026, I received an incident report regarding the incident which occurred on 03/10/2026, written by Home Manager, Kaila Klepsch. Kaila Klepsch informed that Staff, ShunRhoneka Tyler texted her about a situation in which Staff, Alonzo Simmons was yelling at Resident A to get out the room, although Resident A was there with permission from ShunRhoneka Tyler. Recipient Rights were notified. In another Incident Report written by, Staff, Alonzo Simmons, he indicates that he asked Resident A to get out of another resident's room. Resident A refused, became angry and started cursing at him and gave him the middle finger. Staff Simmons then called the Home Manager, Tammy Haley. A conversation was had with Resident A that she cannot go into another resident's bedroom due to her history of theft. The staff person had an assignment given to her by the Home Manager and was supposed to do it alone.

On 05/14/2026, I conducted an exit conference with Licensee Designee, Tony Krasinski regarding the allegation. Tony Krasinski agreed with the findings and informed that the staff member was terminated. Tony Krasinski informed that they have monthly meetings so Alonzo Simmons was aware that he is not supposed to speak to the residents in that manner and that if they want something in that home, they should be able to get it. Tony Krasinski is not sure why Alonzo Simmons would argue back and forth with a resident, knowing that they have a disability and he's supposed to be there to help. Tony Krasinski told Staff Simmons that if things get out of hand, Staff Simmons needs to walk away and allow for another staff to handle it. Tony Krasinski informed that Alonzo Simmons was terminated because they had several meetings with him and there were no changes in his behavior towards Resident A.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(6) A licensee, staff, volunteers, or any person who lives in the facility shall not do any of the following: (f) Subject a resident to any of the following: (i) Mental or emotional cruelty. (ii) Verbal abuse. (iii) Derogatory remarks.
ANALYSIS:	Based on my interviews with Staff and Resident A, there is enough evidence to establish a licensing rule violation. Everyone that I interviewed informed me that there was an issue between Resident A and Staff Alonzo Simmons which resulted in Staff Simmons stating derogatory remarks to Resident A. Staff Simmons used profanity and argued with Resident A based on interviews with Staff, Kaila Klepsch, and Staff Simmons.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(6) A licensee, staff, volunteers, or any person who lives in the facility shall not do any of the following: (e) Withhold food, water, clothing, rest, or toilet use.
ANALYSIS:	Based on my interviews with Staff, Licensee Designee and Resident A, there is not enough evidence to establish a licensing rules violation. Resident A informed that Staff Alonzo Simmons denied her request for banana although all the other residents were able get a banana and it was on the menu. Other staff interviewed were not aware of the issue with the fruit and Alonzo Simmons denied that there were any issues regarding fruit.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that no changes be made to the licensing status of this medium sized adult foster care group home, pending the receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan (capacity 7-12).
