III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.647	Safety and maintenance of premises.
	(6) Plumbing fixtures and water and waste pipes must be properly installed and maintained in good working condition.

During the on-site inspection on 06/04/2026, the sink was not draining properly in bedroom #16.

R 400.681	Resident rights; licensee responsibilities.
	(1) A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect, free from exploitation, and protected and safe.

During the on-site inspection on 06/04/2026, the 16 residents residing at this facility would not be protected and safe by staff members due to the evacuation procedures and practices exceeding eight minutes. I reviewed the evacuation and procedure practices for 2025 and 2026, during day, evening and sleep hours, the evacuation times were between 10 minutes – 25 minutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
