II. Purpose of Addendum

On 06/15/2026, I received an email from Ms. Sonnie-Williams informing me that a second bedroom had been added to the basement of the home. The licensing requirements for basement bedrooms were discussed. Ms. Sonnie-Williams advised she would like the new bedroom added to the license and the capacity increased from five residents to six residents as she believes the room meets licensing requirements.

III. Methodology

On 06/19/2026, I received a BCAL 5055 Request for Modification of Terms of the License. The request was to modify the capacity of the home from five to six residents and approve the addition of a second bedroom to the basement of the home.

On 07/01/2026, I conducted an onsite inspection and measured the new bedroom and change to common areas for the purpose of the change in capacity.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This main floor of the home has one private and one semi-private bedroom. The basement of the home now has one semi-private and an additional private bedroom. The additional private bedroom measures $7'6'' \times 10'5'' + 6'5'' \times 2'11'' = 97$ square feet of floor space and can accommodate one resident. Half the bedroom's height is above grade.

There is a semi-private full bathroom in the basement. The heat plant is located in the basement in a room constructed of materials that provide a 1-hour-fire-resistance rating with a 1-3/4 inch solid core door in a fully stopped frame, equipped with an automatic self-closing device and positive latching hardware

The basement common area measures 73 square feet. The upstairs living room measures 222 square feet. The combined measurements equal 295 square feet which surpasses the 35 square feet per occupant requirement for six residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the modification of the terms of the license to change the capacity from five residents to six residents and approve the use of a new private bedroom in the basement of the home.
