ALLEGATION: On 3/17/2026, direct care staff, Keenya Jordan gave Resident A two doses of Tegretol 200mg and 2 doses of Keppra 500mg via medication error. Staff contacted 911 and Viola was transported to Garden City Hospital and released with staff monitoring at home.

INVESTIGATION: On 5/12/26, I initiated the complaint with an unannounced onsite inspection at the facility. Home manager, Nellie Dixon reported that direct care staff, Keenya Jordan “was improperly passing meds” in the morning on 3/17/26. Ms. Dixon emphasized that Resident A takes “a lot” of daily medication. While at the facility, I observed Resident A’s medication stored in blister-packages affixed to metal rings; each ring is sorted by label with the time of day to be administered. Two rings are for daytime medications, and one ring is for evening medication. According

to Ms. Dixon, Ms. Jordan accidentally took one daytime and one evening ring of medication, instead of both rings for daytime medication. As a result, Ms. Jordan administered Resident A's 8:00 p.m. dose of Carbamazepine 200mg (Tegretol) and Olanzapine (Zyprexa) 20mg at 6:30 a.m. on March 17, 2026. Ms. Dixon indicated that she intervened and stopped Ms. Jordan before she could administer anymore incorrect medication. On 3/17/26, Ms. Dixon instructed Ms. Jordan to take Resident A to Garden City Hospital for evaluation. I reviewed the hospital discharge report; no unusual findings reported. Resident A was medically cleared to return home same day. Per Ms. Dixon, doctors explained that Resident A's risk of harm was minimized since these were her own medications as opposed to someone else's. On 5/12/26, I interviewed Resident A at the facility. Resident A confirmed that she experienced no sickness following the medication error. Resident A said this is the first time staff gave her the wrong medication since being placed in the home. Resident A reported Ms. Jordan was responsible for giving her the wrong medication.

On 5/12/26, I interviewed Ms. Jordan by phone. Ms. Jordan acknowledged she gave Resident A the wrong medication on 3/17/26. Ms. Jordan indicated that she became distracted when Resident A exhibited bad behavior the morning of the incident, in addition to, admitting that she was "really tired" from working "a lot of hours." Specifically, Ms. Jordan stated, "I didn't do my 5 rights ... I just grabbed the meds without looking at them." Ms. Jordan also confirmed that only 2 medications were administered incorrectly and not all the evening medication.

On 5/12/26, I completed an exit conference with licensee designee, Stephanie Kennedy-Kinney. Mrs. Kennedy-Kinney submitted an approved plan of correction on 5/12/26. Ms. Jordan received a 5-day suspension, and she was required to complete a medication refresher course upon her return to work.

	(1) Medication must be given, taken, or applied as prescribed, ordered, or directed by an appropriately licensed health care professional.
ANALYSIS:	On 3/17/26, Resident A's morning medication was not given, taken, or applied as prescribed, ordered or directed by an appropriately licensed health care professional.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable corrective action plan has been received; therefore, I recommend the status of this license remain unchanged.
