III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.629	Direct care staff; qualifications and training.
	(5) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be trained and competent in all of the following areas before performing assigned tasks independently: (c) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation, which includes a hands-on demonstration as part of the training.

I conducted a renewal inspection at Etta's House of Love on 07/21/2026. I reviewed employee records. Staff, Toni Parker's cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification expired 04/09/2026.

R 400.631	Health screenings.
	(2) A licensee shall have on file a statement signed by a licensed physician or physician's designee attesting to the physical health of the licensee, staff, and members of the household. Statements for the licensee and administrator must be signed no more than 6 months before the issuance of a temporary license and at any other time requested by the department. Statements for staff and members of the household must be obtained within 30 days of employment start date, assumption of duties, or occupancy in the facility.

I conducted a renewal inspection at Etta's House of Love on 07/21/2026. I reviewed employee records. Direct care staff, Toni Parker, did not have a signed physician statement on file attesting to the physical health of this staff.

R 400.631	Health screenings.
	(5) A licensee shall maintain documentation of a baseline screening for communicable diseases and records of illness on hiring. Staff who have direct physical contact with residents or resident food may perform those duties only when they are noninfectious or when proper precautions are taken to prevent the spread of a communicable disease. A licensee shall follow a staff's health care professional or local health department

	guidance on controlling the spread of a communicable disease when identified.
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I conducted a renewal inspection at Etta's House of Love on 07/21/2026. I reviewed employee records. Direct care staff, Toni Parker, did not have documentation of a baseline screening for communicable diseases on file.

R 400.639	Staff records.
	(1) A licensee shall maintain a record for each staff that contains all of the following: (f) Verification of not less than 2 reference checks. If reference checks cannot be obtained, documentation verifying reference checks were attempted must be maintained.

I conducted a renewal inspection at Etta's House of Love on 07/21/2026. I reviewed employee records. The employee file for Toni Parker did not contain verification of two reference checks.

R 400.675	Resident medications.
	(1) Medication must be given, taken, or applied as prescribed, ordered, or directed by an appropriately licensed health care professional.

I conducted a renewal inspection at Etta's House of Love on 07/21/2026. I reviewed the Medication Administration Records (MARs) and medications.

Resident A's July 2026 MAR was not initialed for the following:

- Bupropion Hcl XI 150Mg one tablet by mouth daily at 8:00am on 07/4/2026, 07/10/2026, and 07/18/2026.
- Furosemide 20 Mg Tab(R) one tablet by mouth daily at 8:00am on 07/04/2026 and 07/18/2026.
- Risperidone 5Mg tablet one tablet by mouth two times daily on 07/04/2026 at 8:00am, 07/18/2026 at 8:00am, 07/10/2026 at 8:00pm, and 07/17/2026 at 8:00pm.
- Senna Plus 2 tablets by mouth daily at 8:00am on 07/04/2026 and 07/18/2026.
- Melatonin 3 Mg tablet every night at bedtime on 07/04/2026, 07/10/2026, and 07/17/2026.

There was no start date on the medication bubble packs and staff were not following the dates on the bubble pack when administering medications, so it could not be determined if the medications had been administered as prescribed.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

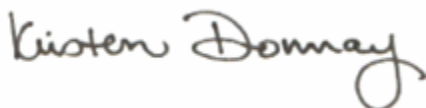
Contingent upon the receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
