III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Physical Description of Facility

The facility is located at 1860 Hope Drive, east of Caro on the north side of M-81. It is a purpose built brick structure that contains 8 bedrooms, 2 dens, 2 full bathrooms, a living room, dining room, kitchen, laundry room, office and mechanical room. The facility was most recently licensed as a Child Caring Institution.

The facility is equipped with fire extinguishers, smoke detectors and a full coverage sprinkler system. The architectural plans were reviewed by the Bureau of Construction Codes Fire Safety Division (BCCFS). A final inspection was conducted on 5-28-05 and the report granting full approval was received in this office on 6-6-05.

B. Program Description

The Lighthouse mission is to provide purpose, privacy, and dignity for all persons in a home-like atmosphere. These persons, either male or female, will include, but not be limited to, the following: the aged, developmentally disabled, mentally ill, pediatrics, physically handicapped and traumatic brain injured.

The therapeutic program is designed to maximize each client's functioning ability as well as assist clients in gaining insight, enhancing self-esteem, developing coping skills, and improving relationships. The setting in which the program is implemented promotes

independence, self-respect, and positive peer relationships in a supportive, caring environment.
