Jusan Barreler

This facility has sufficient overall space to provide 35 square feet of living space per occupant. Three resident bedrooms are available. The licensee's propose placing three beds in the largest bedroom, which has sufficient square footage to allow for 65 square feet per bed, plus three feet in between beds. Two other bedrooms are proposed to house one resident each, although both have sufficient square feet to permit two beds apiece. The licensees may choose how they wish to place the five beds between the three bedrooms, as long as they do not exceed five beds.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the license be modified to increase capacity from four to five residents.
