II. Purpose of Addendum

On January 29, 2007, the licensee requested a modification of the terms of this licensee to increase capacity from 3 to 5 residents.

III. Methodology

01/29/2007 – Inspection completed on site.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Ms. Srebnik has an extra bedroom on the first floor, which she now wants to use as a second resident bedroom. Bedroom 2 has approximately 140 square feet of usable floor space. Therefore bedroom 2 can be licensed for 2 additional residents.

In addition, in November 2006, Ms. Srebnik had an interconnected multistation smoke detection system installed by a licensed electrical contractor, as the licensee has temporary certification to provide specialized programs for the Developmentally Disabled.

Ms. Srebnik would also like to accept aged residents at the home. Ms. Srebnik has past experience working with this population.

V. Recommendation

This consultant recommends an increase in the license capacity to 5.
