II. Purpose of Addendum

A letter from the authorized representative was received on June 16, 2006, requesting a modification of terms to the original license to add the services provided to residents with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia.

III. Methodology

A permit for construction was issued April 10, 2006, by the Bureau of Health Facilities - Health Facilities Engineering Section, for the renovation and conversion of an existing 9 unit – 10 bed wing of this home for the aged. The project was completed and approved by the Bureau of Health Facilities on December 19, 2006.

Approval by the Bureau of Fire Services was obtained December 11, 2006.


During a recent on-site renewal inspection on August 23, 2007, an inspection tour was conducted of the 10 bed Grace Hall, a wing designated specifically for residents with a diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. It was noted that the unit doors are locked and can only be exited when a code is entered. This is to prevent residents from wandering away unsupervised. Staff and residents of this particular area were observed during activities and interactions. Activities and meals are served within the unit. Documentation verified that staff receive ongoing training in Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia to work with these residents. The facility's description of services was also reviewed and found to meet compliance with MCL 333.20178.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

An inspection tour of the facility's Grace Hall, a unit designed for residents with Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia was completed. Review of the approvals by the Bureau of Health Facilities and the Bureau of Fire Services along with confirmation of staff training, observation of staff and resident interaction, and a review of the facility's description of services to persons with Alzheimer's disease or a related condition, completed this inspection. All items met compliance with MCL 333.20178.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the facility's license be modified to include services provided to residents with Alzheimer's disease or a related condition.
