III. Methodology

On December 13, 2007, this licensing consultant physical plant and fire safety inspections.


IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The proposed private northeast bedroom for a 4th resident was inspected. This private bedroom measured 14' 1" x 15' 11" or contained 237.40 square feet of space. This private bedroom featured a sliding glass door for a window and the door was equipped with non-locking-against-egress hardware. This private bedroom was adequately furnished with a bed and dresser. This private bedroom also featured a large walk-in closet. This private bedroom was equipped with an interconnected multi-station smoke detection system that was powered by the household electrical service with battery backup. An emergency evacuation plan including this private bedroom was prominently posted in the home.

The living room contained 306 square feet of space and the dining room contained 121 square feet of space. The Johnson's have two minor children and there is 427 square feet of common space on the main floor for the Johnson family and four residents to share. This equates to 53.375 square feet of common space for the eight occupants of the home.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the capacity of the Bridget Johnson AFC be increased to four residents.
