II. PURPOSE OF ADDENDUM

The facility received approval of a new addition to the existing building and requested an increase in the number of beds from 48 to 78.

III. METHODOLOGY

An on-site inspection of the new addition was completed at the time of the last renewal inspection on October 2, 2007. The addition to the existing home added 30 additional beds, increasing the capacity from 48 to 78.

Each apartment is equipped with a kitchenette (featuring a full size refrigerator/freezer) and a barrier-free bathroom. Emergency-call pull cords are located in each bedroom and bathroom. Heating and air-conditioning are individually regulated to allow for personal comfort. There are two enclosed landscaped courtyards with outside seating areas and a barbecue grill for family events.

IV. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS


The original occupancy approval received from the Bureau of Health Services, Division of Health Facilities Evaluation and Services, dated April 12, 2007, was for an increase of 20 beds. Approval for an increase of 30 beds was revised on April 8, 2008, and received on May 8, 2008.

At the time of the initial on-site inspection, full approval for the new addition had not been received from the Department of Labor and Economic Growth, Bureau of Fire Services. A follow-up inspection was completed by the Bureau of Fire Services on 10/17/07 and fire safety approval was not received until 2/8/08.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.


V. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the capacity of the facility be increased from 48 to 78 beds.
